- Morning of 13 Aug paddle to McMullin Group and camp on North Island
- Spend the next four days paddling this area then retrace our route back to Bella Bella arriving at McLoughlin Ferry Dock around 3 pm on 19 Aug
- Alternate areas that may serve as destinations if weather is unsuitable for McMullin Group include north or west coast of Bardswell Group, the Tribal Group or the McNaughton Group
